The STATE OF NEVADA TAXICAB AUTHORITY makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

1. On October 8, 2013, a public hearing was held regarding the above-entitled matter, in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open Meeting Law, the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), at which time all interested parties appeared and were permitted to be heard.
2. The Taxicab Authority is authorized to allocate additional permanent medallions, pursuant to NRS 706.8824, whenever circumstances require an increase in the number of taxicabs.
3. The following filed Petitions to Intervene and all were permitted to intervene and be heard: (1) A Cab, LLC; (2) Yellow/Checker/Star Cab Companies; (3) Desert Cab Company; (4) Whittlesea Blue and Henderson Taxi; (5) Ace Cab, Inc., Union Cab Co.,

7 the Board finds that there is currently no need for additional taxicabs to service the
8 public.


