**ORDER**

At a regular monthly session of the State of Nevada Taxicab Authority Board, held at the Nevada Taxicab Authority, 1785 E. Sahara Ave., Ste. 200, Las Vegas, NV 89104.

The STATE OF NEVADA TAXICAB AUTHORITY makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

1. On March 25, 2014, a public hearing was held regarding the above-entitled matter (the "Event"), in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open Meeting Law, the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), at which time all interested parties appeared and were permitted to be heard.
2. The Taxicab Authority is authorized to allocate temporary additional medallions, pursuant to NRS 706.88245, whenever circumstances require a temporary increase in the number of taxicabs allocated, pursuant to NRS 706.8824.

- 1 3. The Event is the Electric Daisy Carnival to be held at the Las Vegas Motor Speedway  
2 from Friday, June 20, 2014 through Sunday, June 22, 2014, with an estimated daily  
3 attendance of 130,000.
- 4 4. The following filed Petitions to Intervene and all were permitted to intervene and be  
5 heard: (1) Lucky Cab Company, (2) Ace Cab, Inc., Union Cab Co., A NLV Cab Co.,  
6 Vegas-Western Cab, Inc. and Virgin Valley Cab Company, Inc., (3)  
7 Yellow/Checker/Star Cab Companies, (4) Sun Cab Inc., d/b/a Nellis Cab Company, (5)  
8 Whittlesea Blue/Henderson Taxi, (6) Boulder Cab Inc., dba Deluxe Taxicab Service,  
9 (7) A Cab, LLC, (8) Desert Cab Company, (9) Western Cab Company, (10) ITPE  
10 Union.

- 12 5. Intervenors were allowed to present arguments and evidence regarding the nature of  
13 the event, the expected attendance of the event and the transportation needs of the  
14 attendees of the event.
- 15 6. Based upon the arguments, evidence and recommendations submitted by Intervenors,  
16 the Board finds that there is a need for temporary, additional taxicabs to service the  
17 public at the Event, which the Board, accordingly, finds should be addressed by a  
18 temporary allocation of additional medallions.

- 20 7. Pursuant to NRS 706.88245(2), any temporary allocation of additional medallions must  
21 be apportioned equally among the certificate holders in the area to be affected by the  
22 allocation.

23 THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Administrator shall issue temporary  
24 additional medallions to address the need for additional taxicabs for the above-referenced  
25 event, as follows:

3 12:00 PM to 2:00 AM  
4 (any 12-hour period)

5 and

6 12 medallions per company  
7 6:00 PM to 10:00 AM  
8 (any 12-hour period)

9 **SUNDAY, JUNE 22, 2014**

10 12 medallions per company  
11 12:00 PM to 2:00 AM  
12 (any 12-hour period)

13 and

14 12 medallions per company  
15 6:00 PM to 10:00 AM  
16 (any 12-hour period)

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the authorized additional cabs may be put into service  
18 only during the times and dates set forth herein.
