The STATE OF NEVADA TAXICAB AUTHORITY makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

1. On July 29, 2014, a public hearing was held regarding the above-entitled matter (the "Event"), in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open Meeting Law, the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), at which time all interested parties appeared and were permitted to be heard.
2. The Taxicab Authority is authorized to allocate temporary additional medallions, pursuant to NRS 706.88245, whenever circumstances require a temporary increase in the number of taxicabs allocated, pursuant to NRS 706.8824.

- 1 3. The Event is the M.A.G.I.C. Convention to be held at the Las Vegas Convention and
2 Visitors Authority from Monday, August 18 through Wednesday, August 20, 2014 with
3 an estimated attendance of 90,000.
- 4 4. The following filed Petitions to Intervene and all were permitted to intervene and be
5 heard: (1) Whittlesea Blue/Henderson Taxi, (2) Desert Cab Company, (3)
6 Yellow/Checker/Star Cab Companies, (4) Nellis Cab Company, (5) Western Cab
7 Company, (6) Lucky Cab Company, (7) Ace Cab, Inc., Union Cab Co., A NLV Cab Co.,
8 Vegas-Western Cab, Inc., and Virgin Valley Cab Company, Inc., (8) ITPE Union.
- 9 5. Intervenors were allowed to present argument and evidence regarding the nature of
10 the event, the expected attendance of the event and the nature of the attendees of the
11 event.
- 12 6. Based upon the arguments, evidence and recommendations submitted by Intervenors,
13 the Board finds that there is a need for temporary, additional taxicabs to service the
14 public at the Event, which the Board, accordingly, finds should be addressed by a
15 temporary allocation of additional medallions.
- 16 7. Pursuant to NRS 706.88245(2), any temporary allocation of additional medallions must
17 be apportioned equally among the certificate holders in the area to be affected by the
18 allocation.

21 THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Administrator shall issue temporary
22 additional medallions to address the need for additional taxicabs for the above-referenced
23 event, as follows:

24 **MONDAY, AUGUST 18, 2014**
25 **THROUGH**
26 **WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 20, 2014**
27 5 medallions per company
12:00 PM to 2:00 AM
(any 12-hour period)

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the authorized additional cabs may be put into service
2 only during the times and dates set forth herein.
