24 The STATE OF NEVADA TAXICAB AUTHORITY makes the following findings of
25 fact and conclusions of law.

- 26 1. On October 30, 2014, a public hearing was held regarding the above-entitled
27 matter (the "Events"), in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open
28 Meeting Law, the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 706 of the

1 Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), at
2 which time all interested parties appeared and were permitted to be heard.

- 3 2. The Taxicab Authority is authorized to allocate temporary additional medallions,
4 pursuant to NRS 706.88245, whenever circumstances require a temporary
5 increase in the number of taxicabs allocated, pursuant to NRS 706.8824.
- 6 3. The Events are as captioned above and with a total expected attendance of
7 246,000.
- 8 4. The following filed Petitions to Intervene and all were permitted to intervene and
9 be heard: 1) Boulder Cab Company d/b/a Deluxe Taxicab Service, 2) Nellis Cab
10 Company, 3) Yellow/Checker/Star Cab Companies, 4) A Cab, LLC, 5) Whittlesea
11 Blue/ Henderson Taxi, 6) Lucky Cab Company, 7) Ace Cab, Inc., Union Cab Co.,
12 A NLV Cab Co., Vegas-Western Cab, Inc., and Virgin Valley Cab Company, Inc.,
13 8) Western Cab Company, 9) Desert Cab Company.
- 14 5. Intervenors were allowed to present argument and evidence regarding the
15 nature of the Events, the expected attendance of the Events and the nature of
16 the attendees of the Events.
- 17 6. Based upon the arguments, evidence and recommendations submitted by
18 Intervenors, the Board finds that there is a need for temporary, additional
19 taxicabs to service the public at the Events, which the Board, accordingly, finds
20 should be addressed by a temporary allocation of additional medallions.
- 21 7. Pursuant to NRS 706.88245(2), any temporary allocation of additional medallions
22 must be apportioned equally among the certificate holders in the area to be
23 affected by the allocation.

26 THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Administrator shall issue
27 temporary additional medallions to address the need for additional taxicabs for the
28 above-referenced events, as follows:

1 **MONDAY, JANUARY 19, 2015**

2 20 medallions per company
3 12:00 PM to 2:00 AM
4 (any 12-hour period)

5 **TUESDAY, JANUARY 20, 2015 through THURSDAY, JANUARY 22, 2015**

6 20 medallions per company
7 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM
8 and
9 20 medallions per company
10 12:00 PM to 2:00 AM
11 (any 12-hour period)

12 **FRIDAY, JANUARY 23, 2015**


13 20 medallions per company
14 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM
15 and
16 10 medallions per company
17 12:00 PM to 2:00 AM
18 (any 12-hour period)

19 **SATURDAY, JANUARY 24, 2015**

20 10 medallions per company
21 12:00 PM to 2:00 AM
22 (any 12-hour period)

23 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the authorized additional cabs may be put into
24 service only during the times and dates set forth herein.
