2014, WHICH IS ON A WEDNESDAY

**ORDER**

At a regular monthly session of the State of Nevada Taxicab Authority Board, held at the Nevada Taxicab Authority, 2080 E. Flamingo Rd. #114, Las Vegas, NV 89119.

The STATE OF NEVADA TAXICAB AUTHORITY makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

1. On October 30, 2014, a public hearing was held regarding the above-entitled matter (the "Event"), in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open Meeting Law, the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), at which time all interested parties appeared and were permitted to be heard.
2. The Taxicab Authority is authorized to allocate temporary additional medallions, pursuant to NRS 706.88245, whenever circumstances require a temporary increase in the number of taxicabs allocated, pursuant to NRS 706.8824.
3. The Event is New Year's Eve, which falls on a Wednesday.
4. The following filed Petitions to Intervene and all were permitted to intervene and be heard: 1) Boulder Cab Company d/b/a Deluxe Taxicab Service, 2) Nellis Cab

1 Company, 3) Yellow/Checker/Star Cab Companies, 4) A Cab, LLC, 5) Whittlesea Blue/  
2 Henderson Taxi, 6) Lucky Cab Company, 7) Ace Cab, Inc., Union Cab Co., A NLV Cab  
3 Co., Vegas-Western Cab, Inc., and Virgin Valley Cab Company, Inc., 8) Western Cab  
4 Company, 9) Desert Cab Company.

- 5 5. Intervenors were allowed to present arguments and evidence regarding the nature of  
6 the event, the expected attendance of the event and the nature of the attendees of the  
7 event.

9 6. Based upon the arguments, evidence and recommendations submitted by Intervenors  
10 and staff, the Board finds that there is a need for temporary, additional taxicabs to  
11 service the public at the event, which the Board, accordingly, finds should be  
12 addressed by a temporary allocation of additional medallions.  
13  
14 7. Pursuant to NRS 706.88245(2), any temporary allocation of additional medallions must  
15 be apportioned equally among the certificate holders in the area to be affected by the  
16 allocation.

17 THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Administrator shall issue temporary  
18 additional medallions to address the need for additional taxicabs for the above-referenced  
19 event, as follows:

21 10 medallions per company  
22 12:00 PM to 2:00 AM  
(any 12-hour period)

23 **WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 31, 2014**

24 10 medallions per company  
25 6:00 AM to 8:00 PM

26 20 medallions per company  
27 4:00 PM to 6:00 AM  
28 (any 12-hour period)

1 **THURSDAY, JANUARY 1, 2015**

2 5 medallions per company  
3 4:00 AM to 8:00 PM  
4 and  
5 10 medallions  
6 12:00 PM to 2:00 AM  
7 (any 12-hour period)

8 **FRIDAY, JANUARY 2, 2015**

9 10 medallions  
10 12:00 PM to 2:00 AM  
11 (any 12-hour period)

12 **SATURDAY, JANUARY 3, 2015**

13 10 medallions  
14 12:00 PM to 2:00 AM  
15 (any 12-hour period)

16 **SUNDAY, JANUARY 4, 2015**

17 5 medallions  
18 4:00 AM to 8:00 PM  
19 (any 12-hour period)

20 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrator shall issue temporary additional  
21 medallions for the Laughlin area to address the need for additional taxicabs for the above-  
22 referenced event, as follows:



26 2 medallions per company  
27 (Lucky and Desert only)
