ORDER

At a regular monthly session of the State of Nevada Taxicab Authority Board, held at the Nevada Taxicab Authority, 2080 E. Flamingo Rd. #114, Las Vegas, NV 89119.

The STATE OF NEVADA TAXICAB AUTHORITY makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

1. On October 30, 2014, a public hearing was held regarding the above-entitled matter (the "Event"), in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open Meeting Law, the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), at which time all interested parties appeared and were permitted to be heard.
2. The Taxicab Authority is authorized to allocate temporary additional medallions, pursuant to NRS 706.88245, whenever circumstances require a temporary increase in the number of taxicabs allocated, pursuant to NRS 706.8824.

- 1 3. The Event is the 2015 International CES Convention, running from Tuesday, January
2 6, 2015 through Friday, January 19, 2015, with an anticipated attendance of roughly
3 170,000.
- 4 4. The following filed Petitions to Intervene and all were permitted to intervene and be
5 heard: 1) Boulder Cab Company d/b/a Deluxe Taxicab Service, 2) Nellis Cab
6 Company, 3) Yellow/Checker/Star Cab Companies, 4) A Cab, LLC, 5) Whittlesea Blue/
7 Henderson Taxi, 6) Lucky Cab Company, 7) Ace Cab, Inc., Union Cab Co., A NLV Cab
8 Co., Vegas-Western Cab, Inc., and Virgin Valley Cab Company, Inc., 8) Western Cab
9 Company, 9) Desert Cab Company.

11 5. Intervenors were allowed to present argument and evidence regarding the nature of
12 the event, the expected attendance of the event and the nature of the attendees of the
13 event.
- 14 6. Based upon the arguments, evidence and recommendations submitted by Intervenors,
15 the Board finds that there is a need for temporary, additional taxicabs to service the
16 public at the Event, which the Board, accordingly, finds should be addressed by a
17 temporary allocation of additional medallions.

19 7. Pursuant to NRS 706.88245(2), any temporary allocation of additional medallions must
20 be apportioned equally among the certificate holders in the area to be affected by the
21 allocation.

22 THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Administrator shall issue temporary
23 additional medallions to address the need for additional taxicabs for the above-referenced
24 event, as follows:

1 **TUESDAY, JANUARY 6, 2015 and WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 7, 2015**

2 20 medallions per company
3 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM

4 and

5 20 medallions per company
6 12:00 PM to 2:00 AM
7 (any 12-hour period)

8 **THURSDAY, JANUARY 8, 2015**

9 20 medallions per company
10 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM

11 and

12 20 medallions per company
13 12:00 PM to 2:00 AM
14 (any 12-hour period)

15 **FRIDAY, JANUARY 9, 2015**

16 15 medallions per company
17 12:00 PM to 2:00 AM
18 (any 12-hour period)

19 **SATURDAY, JANUARY 10, 2015**

20 10 medallions per company
21 2:00 PM to 2:00 AM
22 (any 12-hour period)

23 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the authorized additional cabs may be put into service
24 only during the times and dates set forth herein.
