**ORDER**

At a regular monthly session of the State of Nevada Taxicab Authority Board, held at the Nevada Taxicab Authority, 2080 E. Flamingo Rd. #114, Las Vegas, NV 89119.

The STATE OF NEVADA TAXICAB AUTHORITY makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

1. On November 17, 2014, a public hearing was held regarding the above-entitled matter (the "Events"), in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open Meeting Law, the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes

1 (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), at which time all interested parties  
2 appeared and were permitted to be heard.

3 2. The Taxicab Authority is authorized to allocate temporary additional medallions,  
4 pursuant to NRS 706.88245, whenever circumstances require a temporary increase in  
5 the number of taxicabs allocated, pursuant to NRS 706.8824.

6 3. The Events are as captioned above and with a total expected attendance of 69,000.

7 4. The following filed Petitions to Intervene and all were permitted to intervene and be  
8 heard: 1) A Cab LLC, 2) Nellis Cab Company, 3) Yellow/Checker/Star Cab Company,  
9 4) Ace Cab, Inc., Union Cab Co., A NLV Cab Co., Vegas-Western Cab, Inc., and Virgin  
10 Valley Cab Company, Inc., 5) Whittlesea Blue/Henderson Taxi, 6) Lucky Cab  
11 Company, 7) Western Cab Company, 8) Boulder Cab d/b/a Deluxe Taxicab Service, 9)  
12 ITPE Union, and 10) Desert Cab Company.

13 5. Intervenors were allowed to present argument and evidence regarding the nature of  
14 the Events, the expected attendance of the Events and the nature of the attendees of  
15 the Events.

17 6. Based upon the arguments, evidence and recommendations submitted by Intervenors,  
18 the Board finds that there is a need for temporary, additional taxicabs to service the  
19 public at the Events, which the Board, accordingly, finds should be addressed by a  
20 temporary allocation of additional medallions.

22 7. Pursuant to NRS 706.88245(2), any temporary allocation of additional medallions must  
23 be apportioned equally among the certificate holders in the area to be affected by the  
24 allocation.
