The STATE OF NEVADA TAXICAB AUTHORITY makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On February 26, 2015, a public hearing was held regarding the above-entitled matter (the "Event"), in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open Meeting Law, the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), at which time all interested parties appeared and were permitted to be heard.
2. The Taxicab Authority is authorized to allocate temporary additional medallions, pursuant to NRS 706.88245, whenever circumstances require a temporary increase in the number of taxicabs allocated, pursuant to NRS 706.8824.
3. The following filed Petitions to Intervene and all were permitted to intervene and be heard: (1) Desert Cab Company, (2) Nellis Cab Company, (3) ITPE Union, (4)

Whittlesea Blue/Henderson Taxi, (5) Yellow/Checker/Star Cab Companies, (6) Western Cab Company, (7) Lucky Cab Company, (8) Deluxe Cab Company, (9) Ace Cab, Inc., Union Cab Co., A NLV Cab Co., Vegas-Western Cab Co. and Virgin Valley Cab Company, Inc., and (10) A Cab, LLC.

4. Intervenors and staff were allowed to present arguments and evidence regarding the nature of the event, the expected attendance of the event and the nature of the attendees of the event.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Based upon the arguments, evidence and recommendations submitted by Intervenors and staff, the Board finds that there is no need for temporary, additional taxicabs to service the public for the Event, and accordingly, the Board finds there should not be an allocation of temporary medallions.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Administrator shall not issue temporary additional medallions for the above-referenced event.
