The STATE OF NEVADA TAXICAB AUTHORITY makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On April 7, 2015, a public hearing was held in the above-entitled matter in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open Meeting Law, the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, and Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), at which time at which time all interested parties appeared and were permitted to be heard.
2. The following filed Petitions to Intervene and all were permitted to intervene and be heard: (1) Desert Cab Company, (2) Nellis Cab Company, (3) ITPE Union, (4) Whittlesea Blue/Henderson Taxi, (5) Western Cab Company, (6) Lucky Cab Company, (7) Deluxe Cab Company, (8) Ace Cab, Inc., Union Cab Co., A NLV Cab

1 Co., Vegas-Western Cab Co. and Virgin Valley Cab Company, Inc., (9) A Cab, LLC.,
2 and (10) Yellow Checker Star Cab Companies.

- 3 3. Tom Ely, Taxicab Authority Administrator, provided testimony regarding the request to
4 expand the Northern Geographical Boundary for the new Geo-2 restricted Medallions to
5 exclude pick up from the Downtown area.
- 6 4. Intervenors were allowed to present argument and evidence. Industry Intervenors
7 established that it was agreed upon the new Geo-2 restricted Medallions are in a six-
8 month trial period and to change any restrictions would interfere with its current
9 evaluation.

11 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 12 1. Based upon the arguments, evidence and recommendations submitted by intervenors
13 the Board concluded that the new Geo 2 Medallions Northern Boundary would stay the
14 same and would be evaluated at the end of the six-month trial period.

15 ORDER

16 THEREFORE, IT IS SO ORDERED that the new Geo-2 Medallions Northern Boundary
17 will stay the same.
