The STATE OF NEVADA TAXICAB AUTHORITY makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On APRIL 30, 2015, a public hearing was held in the above-entitled matter in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open Meeting Law, the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, and Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), at which time at which time all interested parties appeared and were permitted to be heard.
2. The following filed Petitions to Intervene and were permitted to intervene and be heard:
 - (1) Desert Cab Company, (2) Nellis Cab Company, (3) ITPE Union, (4) Whittlesea

1 Blue/Henderson Taxi, (5) Yellow/Checker/Star Cab Companies, (6) Western Cab
2 Company, (7) Lucky Cab Company, (8) Deluxe Cab Company, (9) Ace Cab, Inc.,
3 Union Cab Co., A NLV Cab Co., Vegas-Western Cab Co. and Virgin Valley Cab
4 Company, Inc., and (10) A Cab, LLC.

5 3. Taxicab Authority Staff and Board Members presented their research and conclusions on
6 whether the original geographically restricted (GEO 1) medallions should be allowed to
7 pick up at the Vdara Hotel and Spa, located at 2600 W. Harmon Ave., Las Vegas,
8 Nevada, and the Mandalay Convention center, located at 3950 S. Las Vegas, Nevada.

10 4. Intervenors were allowed to present argument and evidence. Intervenors all agreed
11 with the analysis of the Board and Staff.

12 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

13 1. Based upon the arguments, evidence and recommendations submitted by Intervenors,
14 Staff, and the Board, the Board concludes that (GEO 1) Restricted Medallions will be
15 modified and the previous Board Order dated February 26, 2015, will be amended to
16 allow (GEO 1) Restricted Medallions to pick up at the Vdara and Mandalay Convention
17 Center.
