

Vehicle Accident Reporting Protocols

STEP ONE

- 1. Determine if there are any injuries.
 - a. Call for medical services.
- 2. Determine if this is a DUI event.
 - a. Contact LVMPD and/or proper law enforcement Jurisdiction.

STEP TWO

- 1. Assess vehicle damage.
 - a. Operable/Inoperable or other
 - b. Major Damage
 - c. Minor Damage
 - d. Other (Cab is on fire, flat tire, etc).

STEP THREE (Taxicab Company Responsibilities)

- 1. Make assessments as described above.
- 2. Immediately contact Taxicab Authority Dispatch.
- 3. Advise whether vehicle has major/minor damage.
 - a. Major damage or inoperable: Call for tow.
 - b. Minor damage or operable (Bumper taps): See step four.

STEP FOUR (Bumper Taps)

- Required information that <u>must</u> be reported to TA dispatch by the Taxicab Company Road Supervisor.
 - a. Is the cab unsafe to drive?
 - b. Are there any fluid leaks?
 - c. Is there anything hanging off the cab?
 - d. Is there any undercarriage damage?
 - e. Depending on areas damaged, are the headlights, tail and or brake lights inoperative?
 - If yes to any of the above the cab MUST be towed to the cab yard.
- 2. If the Taxicab Company Road Supervisor represents that they have not found any of the above, the TA dispatcher will release the vehicle back to duty.

STEP FIVE

- 1. Prior to the TA Dispatcher releasing the Vehicle he/she will request the following information from the Taxicab Company Road Supervisor:
 - a. Name of Supervisor
 - b. TA permit number
 - c. Verify cab number
 - d. Location of accident
 - e. Location of damage to vehicle
- 2. The above information will be submitted to the TA Vehicle Inspection Unit.

STEP SIX

- 1. The Vehicle Inspection unit will inspect subject vehicle as soon as practicable but not more than 48 hours after the vehicle accident. Taxicab Company <u>must</u> provide the vehicle for inspection when requested by the Vehicle Inspection Unit.
- 2. Vehicle Inspector completes Vehicle Damage Report pursuant to state laws.
- 3. Taxicab Companies full cooperation is expected when following these reporting protocols.
