Persons wishing to intervene must file the appropriate pleading in accordance with the procedures of N.A.C. 706.894, and serve their petitions to intervene on all appropriate persons, pursuant to N.A.C. 706.921, no later than **Thursday, March 8, 2018 at 3:00 P.M.** Pursuant to NRS 241.030(1), the State of Nevada Taxicab Authority may conduct a closed meeting to consider the character, allegations of misconduct, professional competence, or physical and mental health of a person.



 - Expanding the use of leased taxicabs and to whom they may be leased;
 - Addressing when a Taxicab Authority Investigator may retrieve a permit from a driver and/or independent contractor;
 - Updating language involving mechanical standards and/or equipment for taxicab vehicles;
 - Increasing the number of permitted passengers in a taxicab equipped for up to six (6) passengers;
 - Limiting vehicle inspections to not exceed one (1) time per year; and
 - Clarifying the meaning of NRS 706.8846(3) as proposed by the Livery Operators Association by
 - (a) permitting the Authority to adopt alternate routes and/or
 - (b) allowing drivers to use a route other than the most direct route for their passengers. Neither option requires the approval of passengers.
