The TAXICAB AUTHORITY makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

1. On the 26th day of January, 2010, a public hearing was held in the above-entitled matter, in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open Meeting Law, the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, and Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC).
2. At this duly noticed meeting, Agenda Item No. 5 was listed as captioned above.
3. The Applicant, GERALD K. BELL, SR., seeks authorization from the Taxicab Authority board to transfer two (2) voting shares of Whittlesea Bell, a Nevada corporation to the Gerald K. Bell and Ann L. Bell Family Trust ("the Trust"). Whittlesea Bell currently holds a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by the Taxicab Authority. The applicant

1 also seeks an order to approve the appointment of the survivor trustee of the Trust to serve as
2 trustee if the transferor were to become deceased, unable or unwilling to serve, and an order
3 approving Gerald K. Bell, Jr. and Bradley B. Bell to serve as successor co-trustees if both the
4 successor trustee and Ann L. Bell were to become deceased, unable or unwilling to serve.

5 4. No parties have sought leave to intervene in this application.

6 5. The Authority finds that the requests outline above are appropriate under NAC
7 706.465.

8 6. Pursuant to NAC 706.465, no change in the holding of shares in the company
9 and no change in the trustees or beneficiaries of the trusts can take place without the prior
10 approval of the Taxicab Authority.

11 GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFORE,

12 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that pursuant to NAC 706.465, the requested transfer of two
13 (2) voting shares from Gerald K. Bell, Sr. to the Gerald K. Bell and Ann L. Bell Family Trust is
14 hereby approved;

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the survivor trustee of the Trust is approved to serve as
16 trustee, if the transferor is to become deceased, unable or unwilling to serve;

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Gerald K. Bell, Jr. and Bradley B. Bell are approved to
18 serve as successor co-trustees of the Trust if both the transferor and Ann L. Bell are to become
19 deceased, unable or unwilling to serve.
