## **ORDER**

The STATE OF NEVADA TAXICAB AUTHORITY makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

- 1. On the 14th day of December, 2010, a public hearing was held regarding the above-entitled matters (the "Events"), in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open Meeting Law, the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), at which time all interested parties appeared and were heard.
- 2. The Taxicab Authority is authorized to allocate temporary additional medallions, pursuant to NRS 706.88245, whenever circumstances require a temporary increase in the number of taxicabs allocated, pursuant to NRS 706.8824.
- 3. Staff recommended the allocation of no temporary, special-event medallions for the above-referenced Events, based upon the estimated combined attendance of the Events,

the nature of the attendees and the events, statistics from recent special event allocations and past allocations for these events.

- 4. The following filed Petitions to Intervene and all were permitted to intervene and be heard: (1) Whittlesea Blue/Henderson Taxi, (2) Desert Cab Company, (3) Yellow/Checker/Star Cab Companies, (4) Nellis Cab Company, (5) A-Cab, LLC, (6) Lucky Cab Company, (7) Western Cab Company, (8) Frias Holding Companies, (9) United Steelworkers Union, and (10) ITPE Union.
- 5. Based upon the testimony of the Intervenors, the Board finds that there is a need for temporary, additional taxicabs to service the public at the Events, which the Board, accordingly, finds should be addressed by a temporary allocation of additional medallions.
- 6. Pursuant to NRS 706.88245(2), the Board is required to allocate the temporary increase in medallions equally among the certificate holders. All companies are entitled to share in the temporary additional allocation, which temporary additional medallions are only to be used in each company's certificated area.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Administrator shall issue temporary additional medallions to address the need for additional taxicabs for the above-referenced events, as follows:

15 medallions per company 12:00 PM to 2:00 AM (any 12 hour period)
