24 The STATE OF NEVADA TAXICAB AUTHORITY makes the following findings of fact  
25 and conclusions of law.

26 1. On the 26th day of April, 2011, a public hearing was held regarding the above-  
27 entitled matter (the "Event"), in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open Meeting  
28 Law, the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes  
(NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), at which time Applicants Ace Cab, Inc.,  
Union Cab Co., A NLV Cab Co., Vegas-Western Cab, Inc., and Virgin Valley Cab Company,  
("Applicants"), Taxicab Authority staff, Intervenors and all interested parties appeared and  
were heard.

1           2.       The Taxicab Authority is authorized to allocate temporary additional medallions,  
2 pursuant to NRS 706.88245 and 706.88237, whenever circumstances require a temporary  
3 increase in the number of taxicabs allocated.

4           3.       Applicants presented arguments and documentary evidence regarding the  
5 nature of the Event, the estimated attendance, and the nature of the attendees and the  
6 events.

7           4.       Taxicab Authority Staff participated in the discussion and recommended that no  
8 temporary allocations be made for the above-referenced Event.

9           5.       The following filed Petitions to Intervene and all were permitted to intervene and  
10 be heard: (1) Yellow/Checker/Star Cab Companies, (2) A Cab, LLC, (3) Western Cab  
11 Company, (4) ITPE Union, and (5) Lucky Cab Company.

12          6.       The following requested and were granted leave to participate as Interested  
13 Parties: (1) Whittlesea Blue Cab Company and Henderson Taxi, and (2) Desert Cab  
14 Company.

15          7.       Based upon the arguments, evidence and recommendations submitted by  
16 Applicants, Intervenors, and Interested Parties, the Board finds that there is a need for  
17 temporary, additional taxicabs to service the public at the Event, which the Board, accordingly,  
18 finds should be addressed by a temporary allocation of additional medallions.

19          8.       Pursuant to NRS 706.88245(2), any temporary allocation of additional  
20 medallions must be apportioned equally among the certificate holders in the area to be  
21 affected by the allocation.

22          9.       The area to be affected by this allocation is Clark County, Nevada.

23                THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Administrator shall issue temporary  
24 additional medallions to address the need for additional taxicabs for the above-referenced  
25 events, as follows:

26                               **5 medallions per company**  
27                               **Beginning 2:00 P.M. on Friday, May 6, 2011**  
28                               **and continuing through 2:00 P.M. on Sunday, May 8, 2011.**

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the authorized additional cabs may be put into service  
2 only during the times and dates set forth herein.
