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21 The STATE OF NEVADA TAXICAB AUTHORITY makes the following findings of fact
22 and conclusions of law.

- 23 1. On the 21st day of June, 2011, a public hearing was held regarding the above-
24 entitled matter (the “Events”), in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open Meeting
25 Law, the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes
26 (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), at which time Applicants Ace Cab, Inc.,
27 Union Cab Co., A NLV Cab Co., Vegas-Western Cab, Inc., and Virgin Valley Cab Company,

1 (“Applicants”), Taxicab Authority staff, Intervenors and all interested parties appeared and
2 were heard.

3 2. The Taxicab Authority is authorized to allocate temporary additional medallions,
4 pursuant to NRS 706.88245 and 706.88237, whenever circumstances require a temporary
5 increase in the number of taxicabs allocated.

6 3. Applicants presented arguments and documentary evidence regarding the
7 nature of the Events, the estimated attendance, and the nature of the attendees and the
8 events.

9 4. Taxicab Authority Staff participated in the discussion, but did not make any
10 recommendation for the above-referenced Event.

11 5. The following filed Petitions to Intervene and all were permitted to intervene and
12 be heard: (1) Nellis Cab Company, (2) Lucky Cab Company, (3) A Cab, LLC, (4)
13 Yellow/Checker/Star Cab Companies, (5) Whittlesea Blue/Henderson Taxi, (6), Desert Cab
14 Company, and (7) ITPE Union. No representative from Western Cab Company was present.

15 6. Based upon the arguments, evidence and recommendations submitted by
16 Applicant and Intervenors, the Board finds that there is a need for temporary, additional
17 taxicabs to service the public at the Event, which the Board, accordingly, finds should be
18 addressed by a temporary allocation of additional medallions.

19 7. Pursuant to NRS 706.88245(2), any temporary allocation of additional
20 medallions must be apportioned equally among the certificate holders in the area to be
21 affected by the allocation.

22 THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Administrator shall issue temporary
23 additional medallions to address the need for additional taxicabs for the above-referenced
24 events, as follows:

25 7 medallions per company
26 Beginning 6:00 P.M. on Friday June 24, 2011
27 and continuing through 6:00 P.M. on Monday June 27, 2011.
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1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the authorized additional cabs may be put into service
2 only during the times and dates set forth herein.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Taxicab Authority Staff shall evaluate the
4 effectiveness of this allocation and report back to the Board regarding this allocation.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Board authorizes the Administrator to remove
6 medallions in proportion to any shortfall, if attendance falls short of expected attendance.
