ORDER

The STATE OF NEVADA TAXICAB AUTHORITY makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

1. On the 22nd day of May, 2012, a public hearing was held regarding the above-entitled matter (the "event"), in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open Meeting Law, the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), at which time Applicants Ace Cab, Inc., Union Cab Co., A NLV Cab Co., Vegas-Western Cab, Inc., and Virgin Valley Cab Company, ("Applicants"), Taxicab Authority staff, Intervenors and all interested parties appeared and were heard.

2. The Taxicab Authority is authorized to allocate temporary additional medallions, pursuant to NRS 706.88245 and 706.88237, whenever circumstances require a temporary increase in the number of taxicabs allocated.

3. Taxicab Authority Staff presented arguments and documentary evidence regarding the nature of the Events, the estimated attendance, and the nature of the attendees

1 and the events and recommended an additional allocation of taxicabs during evening hours
2 for the event.

3 5. The following filed Petitions to Intervene and all were permitted to intervene and
4 be heard: (1) Nellis Cab Company, (2) Desert Cab Company, (3) Yellow/Checker/Star Cab
5 Companies, (4) Lucky Cab Company, (5) United Steelworkers Union, (6), Whittlesea
6 Blue/Henderson Taxi. (7) Ace Cab, Inc./ Union Cab Co./ A NLV Cab Co./ Vegas-Western
7 Cab, Inc./ Virgin Valley Cab Company, (8) Western Cab Company, (9) A Cab, LLC, and (10)
8 ITPE Union.

9 6. Intervenors were allowed to present argument and evidence regarding the
10 nature of the event, the expected attendance of the event and the nature of the attendees of
11 the event.

12 6. Based upon the arguments, evidence and recommendations submitted by Staff
13 and by Intervenors, the Board finds that there is a need for temporary, additional taxicabs to
14 service the public at the event, which the Board, accordingly, finds should be addressed by a
15 temporary allocation of additional medallions.

16 7. Pursuant to NRS 706.88245(2), any temporary allocation of additional
17 medallions must be apportioned equally among the certificate holders in the area to be
18 affected by the allocation.

19 THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Administrator shall issue temporary
20 additional medallions to address the need for additional taxicabs for the above-referenced
21 events, as follows:

23 5 medallions per company
12:00 P.M. (noon) to 2:00 A.M.

26 5 medallions per company
6:00 P.M. to 8:00 A.M.
