ORDER

At a regular monthly session of the State of Nevada Taxicab Authority, held at the Nevada Taxicab Authority, 1785 E. Sahara Ave., Ste. 200, Las Vegas, NV 89104.

The STATE OF NEVADA TAXICAB AUTHORITY makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

1. On December 11, 2012, a public hearing was held regarding the above-entitled matter (the "Event"), in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open Meeting Law, the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), at which time all interested parties appeared and were permitted to be heard.
2. The Taxicab Authority is authorized to allocate temporary additional medallions, pursuant to NRS 706.88245, whenever circumstances require a temporary increase in the number of taxicabs allocated, pursuant to NRS 706.8824.

- 1 3. The Event is New Year's Eve, which falls on a Monday, and thus, the Event will likely
2 be comprised of a four (4)-day weekend from Saturday, December 29, 2011 through
3 Tuesday, January 1, 2013.
- 4 4. The following filed Petitions to Intervene and all were permitted to intervene and be
5 heard: (1) Nellis Cab Company, (2) Yellow/Checker/Star Cab Companies, (3) Desert
6 Cab Company, (4) Whittlesea Blue/Henderson Taxi, (5) Ace Cab, Inc./ Union Cab Co./
7 A NLV Cab Co./ Vegas-Western Cab, Inc./ Virgin Valley Cab Company, (6) Lucky Cab
8 Company, (7) A Cab, LLC, and (8) ITPE Union.
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10 5. Intervenors were allowed to present argument and evidence regarding the nature of the
11 event, the expected attendance of the event and the nature of the attendees of the
12 event.
- 13 6. Based upon the arguments, evidence and recommendations submitted by Intervenors,
14 the Board finds that there is a need for temporary, additional taxicabs to service the
15 public at the event, which the Board, accordingly, finds should be addressed by a
16 temporary allocation of additional medallions.
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18 7. Pursuant to NRS 706.88245(2), any temporary allocation of additional medallions must
19 be apportioned equally among the certificate holders in the area to be affected by the
20 allocation.

21 THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Administrator shall issue temporary
22 additional medallions for the greater Las Vegas area to address the need for additional
23 taxicabs for the above-referenced event, as follows:

and
17 medallions per company
4:00 PM to 6:00 AM
(any 12-hour period)

TUESDAY, JANUARY 1, 2013

17 medallions per company
7:00 AM to 7:00 PM

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrator shall issue temporary additional medallions for the Laughlin area to address the need for additional taxicabs for the above-referenced event, as follows:

2 medallions per company (Lucky and Desert)
12:00 PM to 2:00 AM
(any 12-hour period)

SUNDAY, DECEMBER 30, 2012

2 medallions per company (Lucky and Desert)
12:00 PM to 2:00 AM
(any 12-hour period)

MONDAY, DECEMBER 31, 2012

4 medallions per company (Lucky and Desert)
2:00 PM to 4:00 AM
(any 12-hour period)

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1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the authorized additional cabs may be put into service
2 only during the times and dates set forth herein.
