***Commonly Asked Questions Regarding Tickets and Court:
Your Court Date and Time are Indicated on Your Citation***

PRE-TRIALS:

1. *What are pre-trials?*

Pre-trials are the scheduled time to attend court listed on your ticket. You will have the opportunity to resolve your case or set the matter for trial. The Deputy Attorney General will be present to speak with you about your options and may negotiate the fine for your citation. Failure to attend court will result in a default judgment against you. If your ticket is not resolved at pre-trial, the matter will be set for a trial date.

2. *May I pay my ticket before my pre-trial date?*

Yes, you may pay your ticket in full before your pre-trial date, Monday through Friday (except Holidays) from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

3. *What happens if I fail to attend my pre-trial date?*

Failure to appear for your court date will result in a default judgment against you, the full fine of your ticket will be imposed, and your permit will be immediately suspended until you pay your fine balance in full. ***No payment plans will be accepted.***

4. *Where do I pay my fines?*

Fines may be paid to the Taxicab Authority Office located at 2090 East Flamingo Road, Suite 200, Las Vegas Nevada 89119 during open business hours from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

5. *When and where are pre-trials scheduled?*

The date and time is written on each citation (ticket). Pre-trials are held at 2080 E. Flamingo Rd. Suite 114, Las Vegas, Nevada 89119

TRIALS:

1. *What are trials?*

Trial is your court day to present your defense. You may hire an attorney to represent you. The Deputy Attorney General will present his or her case by calling witnesses and/or providing documents to the court. You will have the opportunity to see the documents and ask questions of the State's witnesses. Once the State finishes presenting its case, you may address the court and explain your side. You may also provide the court with your witnesses and/or

documents. The Judge will decide whether the violation happened. If the violation happened, the Judge will impose a fine for each violation.

2. May I still negotiate my ticket fine on my trial day?

No, ticket negotiations will only take place at pre-trials. The State will seek the full fine amount of your ticket if found guilty on the trial day.

3. May I pay my ticket before my trial date?

Yes, you may pay your ticket in full before your trial date, Monday through Friday (except Holidays) from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

4. What happens if I fail to attend my trial date?

Failure to appear for your court date will result in a default judgment against you, the full fine of your ticket will be imposed, and your permit will be immediately suspended until you pay your fine balance in full. **No payment plans will be accepted.**

5. When are trials scheduled?

If the citation is not resolved at the pre-trial, the court will schedule a trial date.

6. Where do I pay my fines?
