 AUTHORITY IN ENFORCING INDUSTRY
 REGULATIONS, SUCH AS LONG-
 HAULING. FTI IS REQUESTING TAXICAB
 AUTHORITY APPROVAL TO CONDUCT A
 PILOT PROGRAM, FOR A TIMEFRAME
 TO BE DETERMINED, WHEREIN THE
 FRIAS FAMILY OF TAXICAB COMPANIES
 WILL EMPLOY THE RIDEINTEGRITY
 SYSTEM ON ITS OWN VEHICLES. FTI
 WOULD LIKE TO INVITE CERTIFICATE
 HOLDERS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE
 PILOT PROGRAM, ON A VOLUNTARY
 BASIS.

The STATE OF NEVADA TAXICAB AUTHORITY makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

1. On January 29, 2013, a public hearing was held in the above-entitled matter, in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open Meeting Law, the Nevada

1 Administrative Procedure Act, and Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS)
2 and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC).

- 3 2. At this duly noticed meeting, Agenda Item No. 10 was listed as captioned above.
- 4 3. The Applicant, Frias Transportation Infrastructure (FTI), seeks authorization from the
5 Taxicab Authority Board to conduct a pilot program, for a timeframe to be determined,
6 wherein the Frias-managed taxicab companies will employ the RideIntegrity system on
7 its own vehicles and vehicles from other certificate holders, on a voluntary basis.
- 8 4. The following filed Petitions to Intervene and all were permitted to intervene and be
9 heard: (1) Yellow/Checker/Star Cab Companies, (2) Lucky Cab Company, (3) Desert
10 Cab Company, (4) Nellis Cab Company, (5) Whittlesea Blue/Henderson Taxi, (6) A
11 Cab LLC, (7) Ace Cab, Inc., Union Cab Co., A NLV Cab Co., Vegas-Western Cab, Inc.,
12 and Virgin Valley Cab Company, Inc., (8) Western Cab Company, (9) ITPE Union.
- 13 5. Intervenors were allowed to present argument and evidence regarding the proposed
14 pilot program.
- 15 6. Based on the arguments, evidence, and recommendations submitted by FTI and the
16 intervenors, the Taxicab Authority Board finds that a FTI RideIntegrity pilot program,
17 with parameters and timeframe to be determined, is appropriate.
- 18 7. The Taxicab Authority Board also finds that a framework and parameters, including the
19 timeframe, should be established prior to initiation of the FTI RideIntegrity pilot
20 program.
- 21 8. The Taxicab Authority Board also finds that the administrator should form an industry
22 study group to establish recommendations for the framework and parameters of the
23 FTI RideIntegrity pilot program.
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1 9. The Taxicab Authority also finds that the FTI RideIntegrity pilot program industry study
2 group should submit its recommendations for the framework and parameters of the FTI
3 RideIntegrity pilot program to the Taxicab Authority Board for the regular February
4 2013 meeting of the Taxicab Authority Board.

5 GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFORE,

6 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that FTI's request to conduct a pilot program, with
7 timeframe and parameters to be determined, is approved.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a framework and parameters, including the
9 timeframe, shall be established prior to initiation of the FTI RideIntegrity pilot program.
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11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the administrator shall form an industry study group to
12 establish recommendations for the framework and parameters of the FTI RideIntegrity pilot
13 program.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the FTI RideIntegrity pilot program industry study
15 group shall submit its recommendations for the framework and parameters of the FTI
16 RideIntegrity pilot program for Taxicab Authority Board consideration at the regular February
17 2013 meeting of the Taxicab Authority Board.
