The STATE OF NEVADA TAXICAB AUTHORITY makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

1. On October 8, 2013, a public hearing was held regarding the above-entitled matter, in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open Meeting Law, the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), at which time all interested parties appeared and were permitted to be heard.
2. Pursuant to NAC 706.471, the Taxicab Authority is authorized to set, adjust, alter, or change rates, charges, or fares for service by taxicabs in its jurisdiction.
3. Pursuant to NRS 706.8824, on an annual basis, the Taxicab Authority shall review the rates, charges, and fares of the Certificate Holders in its jurisdiction.
4. The following filed Petitions to Intervene and all were permitted to intervene and be heard: (1) A Cab, LLC; (2) Yellow/Checker/Star Cab Companies; (3) Desert Cab
