17	The STATE OF NEVADA TAXICAB AUTHORITY makes the following findings of fact and
18	conclusions of law.
19 20	1. On January 28, 2014, a public hearing was held regarding the above-entitled matter
20 21	(the "Event"), in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open Meeting Law, the
22	Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes
23	(NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), at which time all interested parties
24	appeared and were permitted to be heard.
25	2. The Taxicab Authority is authorized to allocate temporary additional medallions,
26	pursuant to NRS 706.88245, whenever circumstances require a temporary increase in
27	the number of taxicabs allocated, pursuant to NRS 706.8824.

3. The Event is the 2014 NAHB's International Builders' Show and the Kitchen & Bath Industry Show, which will run simultaneously at the LVCVA from February 4, 2014 through February 6, 2014, with an expected attendance of 75,000.

4. The following filed Petitions to Intervene and all were permitted to intervene and be heard: (1) Desert Cab Company, (2) Western Cab Company, (3) A Cab LLC, (4) Nellis Cab Company, (5) Yellow/Checker/Star Cab Companies, (6) Whittlesea Blue Cab Company/Henderson Taxi, (7) Lucky Cab Company, (8) Ace Cab, Inc., Union Cab Co., A NLV Cab Co., Vegas-Western Cab, Inc., and Virgin Valley Cab Company, and (9) ITPE Union.

5. Intervenors and Staff were allowed to present argument and evidence regarding the nature of the event, the expected attendance of the event and the nature of the attendees of the event.

6. Based upon the arguments, evidence and recommendations submitted by Intervenors and Staff, the Board finds that there is a need for temporary, additional taxicabs to service the public at the Event, which the Board, accordingly, finds should be addressed by a temporary allocation of additional medallions.

 Pursuant to NRS 706.88245(2), any temporary allocation of additional medallions must be apportioned equally among the certificate holders in the area to be affected by the allocation.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Administrator shall issue temporary additional medallions to address the need for additional taxicabs for the above-referenced event, as follows:
