15	The STATE OF NEVADA TAXICAB AUTHORITY makes the following findings of fact and		
16	conclusions of law.		
17	1. On November 17, 2014, a public hearing was held regarding the above-entitled matte		
18	(the "Event"), in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open Meeting Law, the		
19	Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes		
20   21	(NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), at which time all interested partie		
22	appeared and were permitted to be heard.		
23	2. The Taxicab Authority is authorized to allocate temporary additional medallions,		
24	pursuant to NRS 706.88245, whenever circumstances require a temporary increase in		

the number of taxicabs allocated, pursuant to NRS 706.8824.

3. The Event is the Super Bowl, which falls on Sunday, February 1, 2015.

- 4. The following filed Petitions to Intervene and all were permitted to intervene and be heard: 1) A Cab LLC, 2) Nellis Cab Company, 3) Yellos/Checker/Star Cab Company, 4) Ace Cab, Inc., Union Cab Co., A NLV Cab Co., Vegas-Western Cab, Inc., and Virgin Valley Cab Company, Inc., 5) Whittlesea Blue/Henderson Taxi, 6) Lucky Cab Company, 7) Western Cab Company, 8) Boulder Cab d/b/a Deluxe Taxicab Service, 9) ITPE Union, and 10) Desert Cab Company.
- Intervenors were allowed to present arguments and evidence regarding the nature of the event, the expected attendance of the event and the nature of the attendees of the event.
- 6. Based upon the arguments, evidence and recommendations submitted by Intervenors and staff, the Board finds that there is a need for temporary, additional taxicabs to service the public at the event, which the Board, accordingly, finds should be addressed by a temporary allocation of additional medallions.
- 7. Pursuant to NRS 706.88245(2), any temporary allocation of additional medallions must be apportioned equally among the certificate holders in the area to be affected by the allocation.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Administrator shall issue temporary additional medallions to address the need for additional taxicabs for the above-referenced event, as follows:

## FRIDAY, JANUARY 30, 2015 through SATURDAY, JANUARY 31, 2015

5 medallions per company 11:00 AM to 3:00 AM (any 12-hour period)

## SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 1, 2015 through MONDAY, FEBRUARY 2, 2015

5 medallions per company 6:00 AM to 8:00 PM (any 12-hour period)

2	only during the times and dates set forth herein.
