Taxicab Authority Staff and Board Members presented their research and conclusions on whether the original geographically restricted (GEO 1) medallions should be allowed to pick up at the Vdara Hotel and Spa, located at 2600 W. Harmon Ave., Las Vegas, Nevada, and the Mandalay Convention center, located at 3950 S. Las Vegas, Nevada.
- 4. Intervenors were allowed to present argument and evidence. Intervenors all agreed with the analysis of the Board and Staff.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based upon the arguments, evidence and recommendations submitted by Intervenors,
Staff, and the Board, the Board concludes that (GEO 1) Restricted Medallions will be
modified and the previous Board Order dated February 26, 2015, will be amended to
allow (GEO 1) Restricted Medallions to pick up at the Vdara and Mandalay Convention
Center.
