- 5. Petitioner wishes to take part in the discussion and possible action regarding the Joint Application of Desert Cab Company and A-Cab Company, which Joint Application (1) contains certain statements of alleged fact regarding Petitioner and certain third-party patents that are inaccurate, and (2) requests an action by the Authority that would significantly affect Petitioner and the common motor carriers to whom Petitioner provides its products and services.
- 6. Petitioner wishes to make certain that its attorneys or other representatives can speak at the hearing regarding the Joint Application.
- 7. Petitioner therefore requests that it be permitted to intervene and join in this proceeding and that it be served with copies of any and all pleadings, notices, papers and exhibits that have been or may be filed in this matter.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests that this Authority enter an appropriate order that:

- 1. Grants permission to the Petitioner to intervene and participate fully in any public hearing with respect to this matter, including the right to offer evidence of any kind, to examine and cross-examine witnesses, and to make arguments and file briefs, as well as participate in all other aspects of this matter; and
  - 2. For such other relief as appears just and proper.
