3. Petitioners are informed, believe and thereon allege that the State of Nevada Taxicab Authority is holding a board meeting and public hearing pursuant to NRS 706.8819 to 706.8824.

4. Petitioners seek to intervene and participate in the Application for a Pilot Program by applicants Whittlesea Blue Cab and Henderson Taxi through their counsel Kimberly Maxson-Rushton, Esq. of Cooper Levenson and their request to conduct a pilot program that will allow a passenger to connect to a taxicab using a technology network company's app.


