The second Pre-Hearing Conference in the above-entitled matter was held Wednesday, May 21, 2025, at 2:00 p.m. with discussions centering around discovery and motion deadlines. All documents will be served on all parties by email AND U.S. mail, with the original plus nine (9) copies delivered to the office of the Taxicab Authority ("TA") for filing no later than 3:00 p.m. on the due date, in order to assure the TA staff has appropriate time to receive and file the documents as oftentimes there is a wait for filing services. Discovery requests and responses are typically exchanged between the parties but do not need to be filed at the TA office, unless relevant to a motion, a hearing, or to the hearing of the contested case itself as the submission of the trial exhibits. There must be proof of service on all parties, with a Certificate of Service or similar attachment, to every document a party wants considered by the TA. All parties will immediately notify the TA's legal secretary Silvia at stoms@taxi.state.nv.us should parties change or alter their address, email, or otherwise have requests to change the service list.

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Discovery: the deadlines imposed for this matter are streamlined and shortened as the Taxicab Authority Board will hear this matter on **September 17-19, 2025**. Dates and deadlines in this matter were promulgated and served on all parties on April 28, 2025, in the filed First Order After Pre-Hearing Conference (a copy of that Order is attached hereto for your convenience.) Please comply with BOTH orders. Do not forget to consult BOTH orders. ADDITIONAL or REVISED deadlines discussed during or resulting from the Second Pre-Hearing Conference are as follows:

- June 18, 2025: Pre-filed testimony of all witnesses, not just experts. (Read together with Order from April 28, 2025.)
- June 23, 2025: Deadline for exchange of Supplemental Expert List and Supplementing Expert Pre-filed testimony.
- July 7. 2025: Deadline for exchange of Rebuttal Expert List and Rebuttal Expert Prefiled testimony.
- July 15, 2025: Deadline for final exchange of Witness List (not expert list) and supplement pre-filed witness and expert witness testimony. If no expert witness and pre-filed testimony have been designated and exchanged by June 23 by a party hereto, there is no need to file a "supplement" as the Hearing Officer will interpret the lack of a timely designation and pre-filed testimony as no expert testimony planned or allowed. Timely filed designation of Rebuttal experts and rebuttal expert Pre-filed testimony must be designated and exchanged by July 7, 2025, otherwise there is no need to supplement today as the Hearing Officer will interpret the lack of a timely designation and pre-filed testimony as no rebuttal expert testimony planned or allowed.

In addition to the terms in the First Order After Pre-Hearing Conference: Prior to filing disputes/discovery disputes, due no later than today, counsel must meet to discuss discovery issues with the same level of detail and legal support as is contained in briefings filed with the TA, together with an affidavit accompanying the discovery motion to detail the specifics of the dispute resolution conference.
- July 27, 2025 (REVISION from July 29): Deadline for Oppositions to Discovery Disputes/other disputes including Dispositive Motions.
- July 29, 2025: Deadlines for Replies/Responses to Oppositions to Discovery Disputes/other disputes including Dispositive Motions.
- July 30, 2025: 3rd Pre-Hearing Conference at the office of the Taxicab Authority, located at 2090 E. Flamingo Road, Suite 200, Las Vegas, Nevada 89119. Among other items, to specifically discuss the extent of the meet and confer Order re stipulations to undisputed facts and law: Prior to this 3rd Pre-Hearing Conference,

counsel must meet and confer to stipulate to undisputed facts and to undisputed law, to condense exhibits and to agree to the admission of certain exhibits, limit duplicative evidence, narrow the issues, and otherwise work towards efficiently conducting their cases before the Board. This Pre-Hearing Conference will be taken off-calendar if the Hearing Officer receives detailed confirmation that the parties have met and accomplished this.

September 5, 2025: Deadline for Pre-hearing Briefs for the Board, which must include a summary of the relevant facts and an explanation of how the law applies to those facts, and how each witness' testimony supports each fact and the law. 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Discovery: the deadlines imposed for this matter are streamlined and likely shortened as the Board intends to hear this matter within a reasonable timeframe of 120-150 days. Therefore, the dates and deadlines set forth below are subject to change, amendment and alteration:

- Thursday May 1, 2025: Deadline for a brief statement (3 pages maximum) by each party re narrowing the law and the issues to be determined by the Taxicab Authority Board.
- May 7, 2025: Deadline for exchange of Index of List of Proposed Exhibits and Witnesses and exchange thereof.
- May 21, 2025: Deadline for Initial List of Experts and their pre-filed testimony.
- May 21, 2025, at 2:00: Second Pre-Hearing Conference at Nevada State Business Center, 3300 W. Sahara, 4th Floor, Nevada Room, Las Vegas, Nevada 89102. Discussion will include, among other things, participation from the parties regarding this current schedule (excepting the May 21 deadline for the Initial List of Expert and their pre-filed testimony), the discovery limitations set forth below, and the ability of the parties to stipulate to facts, applicable law, witnesses and exhibits.
- June 18, 2025: Deadline for Pre-filed testimony of all witnesses (experts due May 21 see above).
- July 16, 2025: Deadline for filing disputes/discovery disputes, with responses thereto due July 29, 2025. Written discovery is limited to twenty (20) on another party in the case, including sub-parts. Responses are due within fourteen (14) calendar days. Objections to written discovery must not be boilerplate but must be stated with specificity including the grounds for the objection with specific reasons including, for instance, why is the request overly burdensome, oppressive, overly broad, or vague? Discovery responses that do not comply will be deemed a waiver of that objection, excepting as to privilege. Depositions are limited to one day of four (4) hours of testimony. Subpoena duces tecum will be given with seven days' notice before service to allow parties time to object. Should a party timely object, do not serve the subpoena until or unless the hearing officer allows.
- August 1, 2025: Deadlines for other Briefs and Motions. Oppositions and responses due within ten days.
- September 3, 2025: Deadlines for Supplemental Exchange of Responsive Documents proposed to be used as Exhibits.
- September 5, 2025: Deadline for Pre-hearing Briefs for the Board, which must include a summary of the relevant facts and an explanation of how the law applies to those facts, and how each witness' testimony supports each fact and the law. Included will be the proposed exhibit index, copies of all proposed exhibits, pre-filed testimony of all witnesses-expert and otherwise.
- September 17,18 & 19: Hearing on the Amended Application at Nevada State Business Center, 3300 W. Sahara, 4th Floor, Nevada Room, Las Vegas, Nevada 89102.

The parties should meet and confer to condense discovery, including stipulations to undisputed facts and law, narrowing the issues to be presented, limiting duplicative evidence, and so forth. If they have not done so by May 21, 2025, an Order regarding the same will be discussed during the Second Pre-Hearing Conference. Also to be considered during the Second Pre-Hearing conference will be the stated limitation of the number of written discovery responses and the stated length of depositions, if any.
