**ORDER**

The STATE OF NEVADA TAXICAB AUTHORITY makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

1. On the 25th day of January, 2011, a public hearing was held regarding the above-entitled matter (the "Event"), in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open Meeting Law, the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), at which time all interested parties appeared and were heard.

2. The Taxicab Authority is authorized to allocate temporary additional medallions, pursuant to NRS 706.8824 and 706.88245, whenever circumstances require a temporary increase in the number of taxicabs allocated.

3. Staff recommended allocation of temporary, special-event medallions for the above-referenced Event, based upon the estimated attendance, and the nature of the attendees and the events. Staff recommended an allocation of 16 additional medallions per company on Saturday, March 5, 2011 from 7:00 A.M.-10:00 P.M. and 16 additional medallions

1 per company on Sunday, March 6, 2011 from 7:00 A.M.-10:00 P.M. Staff also recommended  
2 that the Administrator be delegated the authority to remove temporary medallions in the event  
3 that attendance at the Event falls short of expectations. Additionally, Staff recommended that  
4 the Board order participating certificate holders to provide to Taxicab Authority staff the  
5 number of daily shifts per temporary medallion, the number of trips per temporary medallion  
6 and the revenue per temporary medallion.

7 4. The following filed Petitions to Intervene and all were permitted to intervene and  
8 be heard: (1) Nellis Cab Company, (2) Lucky Cab Company, (3) Yellow/Checker/Star Cab  
9 Companies, (4) Desert Cab Company, (5) Whittlesea Blue/Henderson Taxi, (6) United  
10 Steelworkers Union, (7) ITPE Union, (8) Frias Holding Company, and (9) A Cab, LLC.

11 5. Based upon staff's recommendations, as well as the testimony and  
12 recommendations of the Intervenors, the Board finds that there is a need for temporary,  
13 additional taxicabs to service the public at the Events, which the Board, accordingly, finds  
14 should be addressed by a temporary allocation of additional medallions.

15 6. Pursuant to NRS 706.88245(2), the Board is required to allocate the temporary  
16 increase in medallions equally among the certificate holders. All companies, except those  
17 specifically prohibited by their certificates, are entitled to share in the temporary additional  
18 allocation, which temporary additional medallions are only to be used in each company's  
19 certificated area.

20 THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Administrator shall issue temporary  
21 additional medallions to address the need for additional taxicabs for the above-referenced  
22 events, as follows:

23 **FRIDAY MARCH 4, 2011**  
24 10 medallions per company  
25 12:00 P.M. to 2:00 A.M.  
26 (any 12-hour period)  
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**SATURDAY, MARCH 5, 2011**

10 medallions per company  
7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M.

*and*

10 medallions per company  
12:00 P.M. to 2:00 A.M.  
(any 12-hour period)

**SUNDAY, MARCH 6, 2011**

18 medallions per company  
7:00 A.M. to 2:00 A.M.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the authorized additional cabs may be put into service only during the times and dates set forth herein.
