IN THE MATTER OF TEMPORARY ALLOCATIONS OF MEDALLIONS FOR THE 2011 SUPER BOWL WEEKEND

The STATE OF NEVADA TAXICAB AUTHORITY makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

- 1. On the 25th day of January, 2011, a public hearing was held regarding the above-entitled matter (the "Event"), in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open Meeting Law, the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), at which time all interested parties appeared and were heard.
- 2. The Taxicab Authority is authorized to allocate temporary additional medallions, pursuant to NRS 706.8824 and 706.88245, whenever circumstances require a temporary increase in the number of taxicabs allocated.
- 3. Staff recommended allocation of temporary, special-event medallions for the above-referenced Event, based upon the estimated attendance, and the nature of the attendees and the events. Staff recommended an allocation of 10 additional medallions per company on Friday, February 4, 2011 from 12:00 P.M.- 2:00 A.M.; 10 additional medallions

per company on Saturday, February 5, 2011 from 7:00 A.M.-7:00 P.M. and 10 additional medallions from 12:00 P.M.- 2:00 A.M; 5 additional medallions per company on Sunday, February 6, 2010 from 7:00 A.M.-7:00 P.M. and 5 additional medallions from 12:00 P.M.- 2:00 A.M. Staff also recommended that the Administrator be delegated the authority to remove temporary medallions in the event that attendance at the Event falls short of expectations. Additionally, Staff recommended that the Board order participating certificate holders to provide to Taxicab Authority staff the number of daily shifts per temporary medallion, the number of trips per temporary medallion and the revenue per temporary medallion.

- 4. The following filed Petitions to Intervene and all were permitted to intervene and be heard: (1) Nellis Cab Company, (2) Lucky Cab Company, (3) Yellow/Checker/Star Cab Companies, (4) Desert Cab Company, (5) Whittlesea Blue/Henderson Taxi, (6) United Steelworkers Union, (7) ITPE Union, (8) Frias Holding Company, and (9) A Cab, LLC.
- 5. Based upon staff's recommendations, as well as the testimony and recommendations of the Intervenors, the Board finds that there is a need for temporary, additional taxicabs to service the public at the Events, which the Board, accordingly, finds should be addressed by a temporary allocation of additional medallions.
- 6. Pursuant to NRS 706.88245(2), the Board is required to allocate the temporary increase in medallions equally among the certificate holders. All companies, except those specifically prohibited by their certificates, are entitled to share in the temporary additional allocation, which temporary additional medallions are only to be used in each company's certificated area.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Administrator shall issue temporary additional medallions to address the need for additional taxicabs for the above-referenced events, as follows:

FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 4, 2011

10 medallions per company 12:00 P.M. to 2:00 A.M. (any 12-hour period)

1	SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 5, 2011 10 medallions per company
2	7:00 AM to 7:00 PM and
3	10 medallions per company 12:00 PM to 2:00 AM
4	(any 12-hour period)
5	SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 6, 2011
6	5 medallions per company 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM
7	and 5 medallions per company
8	12:00 PM to 2:00 AM
9	(any 12-hour period)
10	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the authorized additional medallions may be put into
11	service only during the times and dates set forth herein.
12	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Board hereby delegates to the Administrator the
13	authority to remove medallions in proportion to any shortfall, if attendance for the Event falls
14	short of expected attendance.
15	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each certificate holder that participates in the
16	allocation of temporary medallions authorized by this order shall provide to the Taxicab
17	Authority the following information in the format prescribed by Staff: the number of daily shifts
18	per temporary medallion, the number of trips per temporary medallion and the revenue per
19	temporary medallion.
