The STATE OF NEVADA TAXICAB AUTHORITY makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

- 1. On November 15, 2013, a public hearing was held regarding the above-entitled matter, in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open Meeting Law, the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), at which time all interested parties appeared and were permitted to be heard.
- 2. The following filed Petitions to Intervene and all were permitted to intervene and be heard: (1) A Cab, LLC; (2) Sun Cab Inc. d/b/a Nellis Cab Company; (3) Yellow/Checker/Star Cab Companies; (4) Whittlesea Blue/Henderson Taxi; (5) Ace Cab, Inc., Union Cab Co., A NLV Cab Co., Vegas-Western Cab, Inc., and Virgin Valley

- 3. The Applicant and Intervenors were allowed to present argument and evidence regarding the above-agendized item.
- 4. The Applicant argued that this proceeding to modify the Applicant's CPCN should be governed by NRS 706.391 and its corresponding regulations.
- 5. The Intervenors argued that this proceeding to modify the Applicant's CPCN should be governed by NRS 706.8827 and its corresponding regulations.
- 6. Based upon the arguments, evidence and recommendations submitted by the Applicant and Intervenors, the Board finds that there is a need to issue a declaratory order.
- 7. Pursuant to NAC 706.982, the Board must issue declaratory orders within 60 days after granting the application, or within 120 days if good cause exists for an extension.
- 8. The Applicant and Intervenors agree to allow the Board to issue its declaratory order at the January 28th, 2014 Board meeting, regardless of whether the January 28th, 2014 Board meeting falls within 60 days after granting the application.
- 9. Pursuant to NAC 706.984, the Administrator must review the comments of the Board members on this issue, research the issue, seek the assistance of the Office of the Attorney General, and submit a draft declaratory order for Board approval.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFORE,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Application for Declaratory Order is granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Board will issue its declaratory order at the January 28th, 2014 Board meeting.
